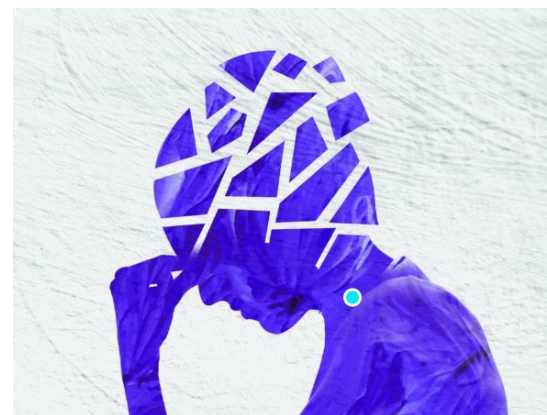
This dinner will be our 24th consecutive monthly outing to enjoy good food, friendly conversations, and support family run restaurants.

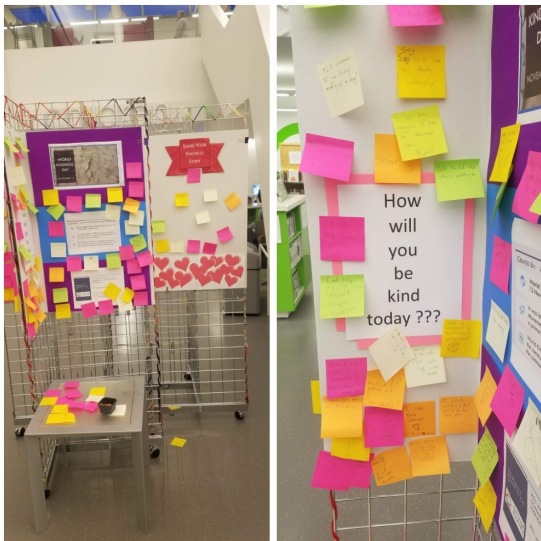
