

Here are the details:

- Do Good Roseville is managing the sign-up process and will be responsible for assigning the spots for each person.
- Calvary Church is providing the parking lot space. You will be assigned a space equal to two parking spaces (approx. 19' x 17')
- You will provide your own tables and chairs.
- You may bring a canopy. This will be in open parking lot, with no shade. Please bring sun protection and water!
- You will be responsible for removing everything at the end of the sale. There will be no garbage disposal available.
- Setup time will begin at 9:00 am. We will ask you to drive in, drop things off, then park in the lot before you setup.
- Everything must be removed by 4:30 pm.
- There will be no bathroom facilities on-site. There are bathrooms available at the Lexington park building on the other side of Lexington, and a Speedway 1 block away.
