Eligibility

Students who attend school or live in cities that comprise the Roseville Area School District (Roseville, Shoreview, Little Canada, Falcon Heights, Lauderdale, Maplewood, Arden Hills)

Prizes - Top 3 entries in each category will be awarded a cash prize

- 2nd Place \$40

Judging Criteria

All submissions will be judged on 3 criteria:

1. **Creativity and Originality:** How unique and imaginative is the work?
2. **Theme/Concept:** Does the work reflect an understanding of Juneteenth?
3. **Overall Impact:** Does the work capture attention and make an impression?
