
Tree Planting at Central Park Elementary


We've got enough squares for 6 more blankets. If you want to be part of this project, I'd be happy to give you a set of 20 squares to stitch together (however you choose).

On your way to the shelter you can shop with 40+ Black-owned businesses, and learn about 20+ organizations providing services in our community.






