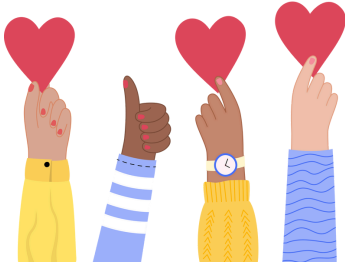

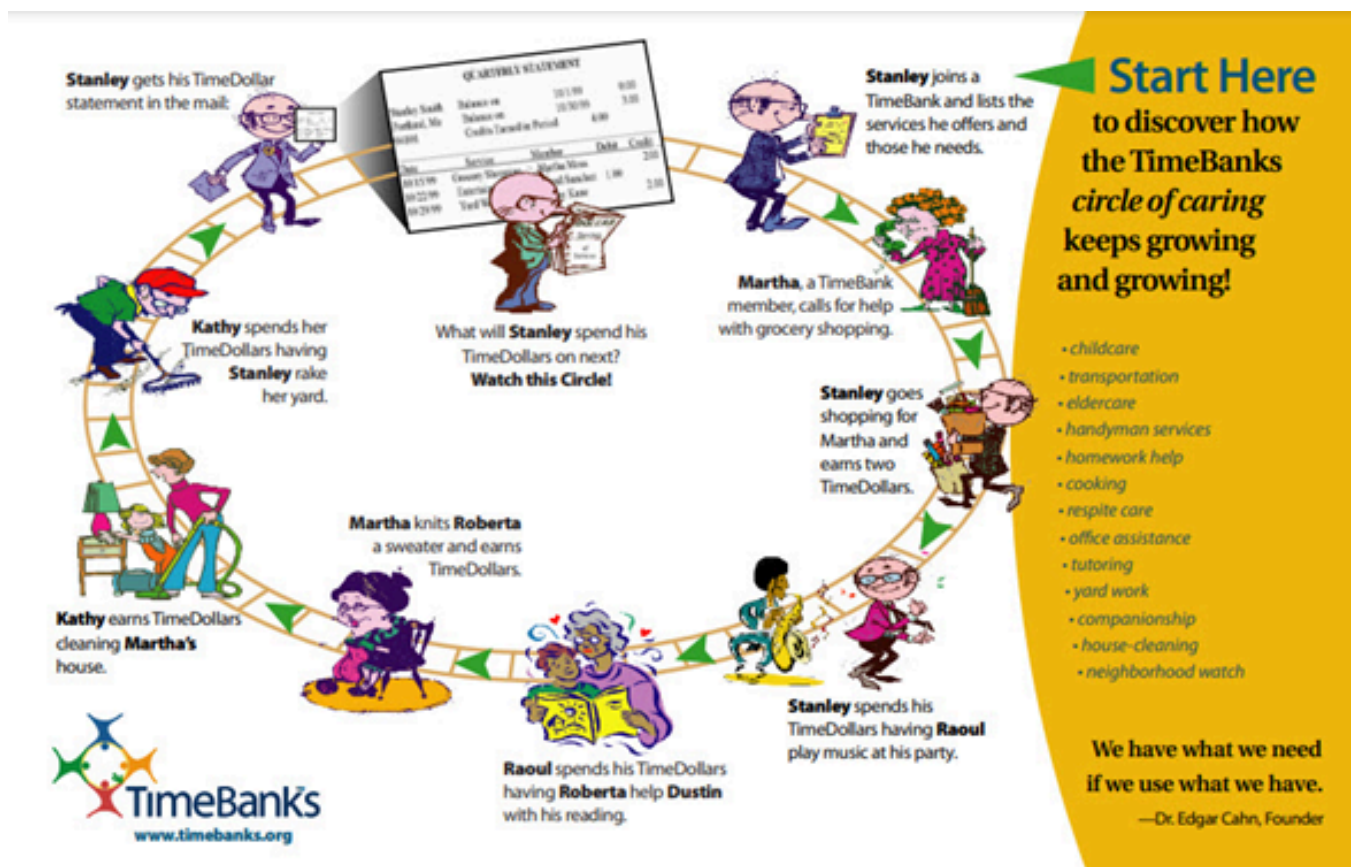


## What is a Time Bank? Is it Right for Roseville?
